Evangel North Church – Wedding Facility Use FAQs

Helping You Celebrate Your Covenant in Christ

? Who can perform weddings at Evangel North Church?

Only **Dr. John Carmichael**, our campus pastor, may officiate weddings in our facility. While he does not charge a fee, it is customary to give him a personal offering as a sign of gratitude.

? Can I bring in my own pastor or officiant?

No. All weddings must be officiated by Dr. Carmichael to ensure alignment with the church's vision and pastoral care.

? Do I have to clean the building after the wedding?

Yes. Every room used (sanctuary, foyer, restrooms, dressing rooms) must be cleaned and restored.

- You may do it yourself (subject to approval).
 - Or pay our **housekeeping team \$175**.

? Can I use the church sound or video system?

Yes, but only **Evangel North's Media Team** may operate our equipment. The **\$100 fee** ensures audio and video are handled with excellence.

? Is there someone who will help me coordinate the wedding?

Yes. All weddings will work with a **Wedding Coordinator** appointed by the church to assist you and coordinate with Dr. Carmichael, housekeeping, and media.

? What does it cost to use the church for a wedding?

There is **no charge for use of the facility**, but the following fees apply if services are needed:

- **Housekeeping:** \$175
 - **Media Team:** \$100
 - **Pastor Offering:** Customary, not required
 - **Wedding Coordinator:** May be volunteer or set by arrangement

? Can we have candles, flower petals, or special decorations?

Yes, with approval.

- Candles must be flame-safe and enclosed.
 - No nails, glue, or tacks.
 - All décor must be removed afterward.
 - Real flower petals require clean-up approval.

? Can we serve alcohol or smoke on the property?

No. Alcohol and tobacco are strictly prohibited on Evangel North's campus.

? When should I schedule my wedding?

At least **60 days in advance**. Rehearsals must also be scheduled and will not conflict with regular church services.

? How do I get started?

Contact the church office to schedule a consultation with Dr. Carmichael and the Wedding Coordinator. You'll then complete a Facility Use Agreement and secure your dates.
