## Matthew 6:9-13

- **Matthew 6:9-13, Luke 11**
- Larry Lea taught that the Jewish Rabbis believed there were seven arteries to the spirit but never discovered what they were.
- Parental, Presence, Priorities, Provision, Pardon, Power, Partnership
- Seven spiritual principles to base prayer...1. Recite Prayer, 2. Use as Outline, 3. Understand Principles

**What is in The Lord’s Prayer that makes it special.**

**There are seven needs that are addressed in The Lord’s Prayer.**

**I. Parental Need - “Our Father who is in heaven,**

- Picture Calvary and thank God, you can call Him our Father by virtue of the blood of Jesus.
- Identity, Authority, Relationship
- This sets the stage to our prayers: our identity, our authority, our relationship.
- [Heb 4:16 NASB95] 16 Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

**II. Presence Need - Hallowed be Your name....” Mat. 6:9**

- He dwells where His Name is
  - [1Ki 8:29 NASB95] 29 that Your eyes may be open toward this house night and day, toward the place of which You have said, 'My name shall be there,' to listen to the prayer which Your servant shall pray toward this place.
  - [Mat 18:20 NASB95] 20 "For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst."

	Yahweh-shalom	The Lord is Peace (Jdg. 6:24 & Phil. 4:7-9)

Security	Yahweh-nissi	The Lord My Banner (Ex. 17:15 & 2 Cor. 2:14)

Salvation	Jesus	Yahweh is Salvation

- Hallow the names of God corresponding with the benefits in the New Covenant and make your faith declarations. Praying the Names of God keeps you praying correctly.

**III. Priority Need - “Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. ...”**

- Lay your will aside, Declare His Will (it is declarative)
- Areas:
  - Yourself
  - Your family (spouse, children, other family members)
  - Your church (pastor, leadership, faithfulness of the people, harvest, etc.)
  - Nation (city, state and national political and spiritual leaders, a specific nation)
  - The nations (pick a nation; pray for Israel daily)
- We must give ourselves wholly to the Will of God
- Stop waiting for things to just happen and prayerfully command things to change

- Expect God to answer and intervene on our behalf

### IV. Provision Need - "Give us this day our daily bread,"

- Be in the will of God (prayer life, church, work habits, obedience in giving)
- Believe it is God's will to prosper you. Be specific. Be tenacious.
- NRSV & LSB same note: "our bread for tomorrow"
- [Rom 8:32 NASB95] 32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?
- Since God gave us Jesus, we can believe Him for everything we need.

### V. Pardon Need - "And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us..."

- Ask God to forgive you.
- Forgive and release others
- Set your will to forgive those who sinned against you
- Forgiveness from God: I John 1:9
- Forgiveness to Others: Mark 11:25-26
- Forgiveness of Ourselves: I Timothy 1:15-16

### VI. Power Need - "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil..."

- Put on the whole armor of God, the Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 6:14-17)
  - Loins girt about with truth
  - Breastplate of righteousness
  - Feet shod with the preparation (readiness) of the gospel of peace
  - Shield of faith
  - Helmet of salvation
  - Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word (rhema) of God
  - Praying always in the Spirit
- Pray a hedge of protection (the Lord is your refuge, your fortress, your God, in Him you will trust) Ps. 91
  - Because you have made the Lord your habitation
  - Because you have set your love upon Him
  - Because you know His name.
- You are never going to outgrow spiritual warfare, so you might as well learn how to fight.
- Jesus had to deal with satan, Paul had to deal with satan, we are going to have to deal with satan.
- [1Pe 5:8-9 NASB95] 8 Be of sober [spirit,] be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. 9 But resist him, firm in [your] faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.
- Resist the forces of darkness, that are trying to destroy you.

### VII. Partnership Need - "For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever."

- [Mar 11:23 NASB95] 23 "Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it will be [granted] him.
  - More saying than praying in this verse.
  - Make your faith declaration
  - Return to praise
- 
- God wants to meet every need you have.
  - Needs are not automatically met. Must pray and release your faith.
  - Set a time. Show up.

[Mat 6:9-13 NASB95] 9 "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 10 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. 11 'Give us this day our daily bread. 12 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]"

[Pro 18:21 NASB95] 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

[2Ki 4:23-26 NASB95] 23 He said, "Why will you go to him today? It is neither new moon nor sabbath." And she said, "[It will be] well." 24 Then she saddled a donkey and said to her servant, "Drive and go forward; do not slow down the pace for me unless I tell you." 25 So she went and came to the man of God to Mount Carmel. When the man of God saw her at a distance, he said to Gehazi his servant, "Behold, there is the Shunammite. 26 "Please run now to meet her and say to her, 'Is it well with you? Is it well with your husband? Is it well with the child?'" And she answered, "It is well."

[Num 14:1 NASB95] 1 Then all the congregation lifted up their voices and cried, and the people wept that night.

[Luk 17:6 NASB95] 6 And the Lord said, "If you had faith like a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and be planted in the sea'; and it would obey you.

[Mat 21:21-22 NASB95] 21 And Jesus answered and said to them, "Truly I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' it will happen. 22 "And all things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."

[Rom 4:17 NASB95] 17 (as it is written, "A FATHER OF MANY NATIONS HAVE I MADE YOU") in the presence of Him whom he believed, [even] God, who gives life to the dead and calls into being that which does not exist.

[Mar 11:23-24 NASB95] 23 "Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it will be [granted] him. 24 "Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be [granted] you.

[Luk 6:45 NASB95] 45 "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the evil [man] out of the evil [treasure] brings forth what is evil; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart.

[Rom 10:9-10 NASB95] 9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus [as] Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.
